## Policy Updates

### Ongoing Threat Level

UK terror threat levels	
<small>(as of February 9 2022)</small>	
<b>CRITICAL</b>	An attack is highly likely in the near future
<b>SEVERE</b>	An attack is highly likely
<b>SUBSTANTIAL</b>	An attack is likely
<b>MODERATE</b>	An attack is possible, but not likely
<b>LOW</b>	An attack is highly unlikely

The UK Threat level is *Substantial* (09/02/2022), which means a terrorist attack is likely.
